## By rail

**Vannes railway station**  
From Paris, Nantes, and Rennes...

### Traveling to the campsite from Vannes:

By bus: Proceed to the "Hugo" stop, which is a 10-minute walk from Vannes train station. Then, board line 3 for a duration of 15 minutes and disembark at the "Camping" stop. A ticket purchased with a credit card costs €1.50, while the cash fare is €2. [Verify schedules and additional information.](#)

## By bicycle

**La Littorale - Route 5:**  
bicycle path along the Breton coastline

From the cycling path, you will arrive at the campsite in 4 minutes by bicycle (1.2 km).



## Carpooling

## Through transportation

*Kicéo buses!*

Line 3 of the Kicéo Buses covers the entire city of Vannes. [Please refer to the timetables and additional information.](#) The "Camping" stop is the nearest and is serviced roughly every 30 minutes.

Tickets can be purchased through the Kicéo app or directly on the bus: €1.50 with a credit card, €2 in cash.

Buses operate throughout the entire year. Bicycles are prohibited on board. For more details, visit [kiceo.fr](http://kiceo.fr).
